A. Achievements:

1. IIT Kanpur: Project has been successfully completed.

2. HPSEB, Himachal Pradesh: SAT successfully completed.

B. NSGM Smart Grid Projects

1. CED, Chandigarh: Technical bids for AMI and SCADA evaluated.

2. MSEDCL, Maharashtra: Tenders are live for SG projects at Amravati and Congress Nagar.

3. **New Proposals:** New SG project proposals received for Jaipur (JVVNL), Rourkela (OPTCL), Ranchi (JBVNL) and Kochi (KSEB) towns.

C. Pilot Projects

CESC, Mysore: Application integration in progress. Rs.4.88 Cr. released towards 3rd installment for SG pilot project.

2. PED, Puducherry: 2400 meters and 3 DCU installed. Next lot of 14,500 meters received.

3. UHBVN, Haryana: 9700 meters and 62 DCUs installed.

 UGVCL, Gujarat: 8200 meters received at site. Data of 248 meters at Control Centre to be made available by 15th April 2018.

5. **TSSPDCL**, **Telangana**: Inspection for automation components completed. Except for autoreclosures, all other automation equipment received at stores. Developmental testing of single phase Smart Meters completed and submitted for type testing to CPRI.
